TONIGHT'S MATCHUP



Vermont Green FC vs AC Connecticut

USL League Two Saturday, June 1, 2024 6:00 pm Kickoff

Vermont Green FC and AC Connecticut will face off for just the third time on Saturday night. The matchup between the two sides has a high-scoring history, with 19 goals being scored in only 180 minutes of football between them. In 2022, the Green defeated the Connecticut side in Hartford by a score of 6-4, and in 2023 the match ended 6-3 at Virtue Field in favor of the Green.

AC Connecticut will come to Burlington on Saturday with 1-1-1 record, sitting on 4 points and in 4th place, just one spot behind the Green. They are coming off an exciting 3-2 victory over Albany Rush on the road on Wednesday, May 29.

The Virtue Field faithful will see a very recognizable face in the Connecticut XI on Saturday as Sam McCann is expected to lead the line for his hometown team. The lanky striker famously scored the winning goal for Vermont Green FC against Lionsbridge FC in the 2022 USL League Two playoffs, completing the upset of the overall top seed of that year's tournament and cementing himself in Vermont Green lore. Once a Green, always a Green, but on Saturday night the home side will need to be diligent to thwart the signature runs of McCann and his new teammates.

HONORING AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY

Vermont Green FC is playing *Lift Every Voice and Sing*, often referred to as "The Black National Anthem," at every home match to celebrate African American freedom and achievement and respect for all cultures. The Club started this tradition to honor Juneteenth – the effective end of slavery in the United States – and will continue honoring our shared history each time we take the pitch. The hymn was written as a poem by NAACP leader James Weldon Johnson in 1900. His brother, John Rosamond Johnson (1873–1954), composed the music for the lyrics.

At the turn of the 20th century, Johnson's lyrics eloquently captured the solemn yet hopeful appeal for the liberty of Black Americans and was later adopted by NAACP and prominently used as a rallying cry during the Civil Rights Movement of the 1950s and 1960s. King Street Center

Vermont Green FC is partnering with King Street Center to make matches more accessible and inviting to historically marginalized communities. The program is focused on building community ties between VGFC players and King Street Center youth and families. Players will join King Street Center youth each week to engage in soccer activities and discuss their path toward playing soccer at the highest levels. Vermont Green will host King Street Center youth at weekly practices and donate free tickets through its "Spread the Love" initiative so they can attend home games throughout the season.

Juba Star FC

We are partnering with Juba Star Football Club to expand access to soccer and work towards equitable play in the state. Juba Star FC is a Somali Bantu-led organization that has operated in the state since 2006. The organization was established to provide a safe space for the growth and development of former refugee and immigrant youth in Vermont. The organization runs free soccer clubs for youth and adults, ages 14 and older, and provides assistance with transportation to games and practices, and mentorship for youth.

Anti Racist Soccer Club

Anti-Racist Soccer Club is a coalition of players, clubs, and experts fighting racism in American soccer. The ARSC membership is open to teams and leagues at the professional and youth levels, supporter groups, and any other soccer-affiliated organization. ARSC works with interested parties to develop a ten-point plan anti-racism framework that is unique to that community. ARSC monitors and evaluates member plans to ensure accountability.
